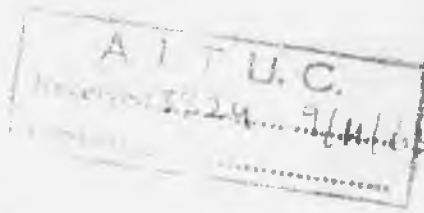

We came to understand that AITUC is holding its Annual Conference at Indore in the month of December, 1965. You must be aware that the General Secretary of this Union Comrade Ananda Prasad Pathak and Com. Krishna Bhakta Sharma a vice-president of the Union have already been arrested under DIR. Two separate cases under Sec. 41-DIR have been instituted against Comrade Ratanlal Braham, president of the union. These cases are pending in the local courts and therefore he has to attend the court regularly. Com. S.P. Lepcha, another vice-president of the union is facing a criminal case (alleged attempt to murder) in the district court. One of the executive members Com. Jalkumar Chhetri was detained in the jail as under trial prisoner for more than 5 months and was prosecuted under Sec. 41-D-IR but recently acquitted and again prosecuted in another case 341 Cr. P.C. Another two executive members Coms. Deepak Rai and Bhuwan Singh Gurung have been prosecuted under Cr. P.C. (alleged attempt to murder).

Under such circumstances ~~circumstances~~ it will not be possible on our part to attend the said conference and therefore, you are requested to kindly postpone the said ensuing conference.



PREPARATIONS FOR THE ALL INDIA TRADE UNION CONGRESS
27TH SESSION AT INDORE.

Seventh Conference of the Madhya Pradesh Trade Union Congress on 16th June '65 welcomed the decision of the A.I.T.U.C. to hold the 27th Session at Indore in Madhya Pradesh and appealed to all its affiliated and brother Unions to give all possible help and make this Session a big success.

Since then the Nation has passed through great ordeal due to Indo-Pak war (Pakistani aggression on In. Kashmir) and it was thought that the conference would not take place in this year.

Immediately after the cease fire, the Secretariat of the A.I.T.U.C. informed M.P.T.U.C. to go ahead with the preparations of the Conference.

In the last month, the Working Committee of M.P.T.U.C. which according to the Constitution was turned into Reception Committee with Com. Shakirali Khan as its President and Homi Daji M.P. as its General Secretary.

During the last month several meetings were held in different sections of the working-class and two big rallies were held in which the importance of the Session was explained in the back-ground of the anglo-american machinations against the Indian policy of peace, non-alignment and economic development. Com. Homi Daji and Com. Shakirali Khan M.L.A. addressed meetings at Indore, Ujjain, Dewas, Mhow and Ratlam appealing for help.

Posters and thousands of pamphlets are pasted and distributed in not only the working-class but different sections of the people.

Organisations of different trades have welcomed the decision of the Conference and collecting donations ~~thru~~ through their own organisations.

In their absence control over the disruptive elements may not be possible. And the conference in that case may end in chaos.

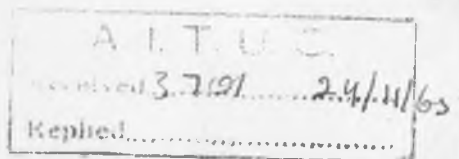
