अधिसूचना

नई दिल्ली, 8 अक्टूबर, 2004

को.आ. 1095(अ).—केन्द्रीय सरकार, ठेका श्रम (विनियमन और उत्पादन) अधिनियम, 1970 (1970 का 37) की धारा 31 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, केन्द्रीय ठेका श्रम सलाहकार बोर्ड से परामर्श करने के पश्चात्, ईस्टर्न कोल फ़िल्ड्स लिमिटेड को भारत सरकार के श्रम मंत्रालय की अधिसूचना सं. को.आ. 2063 तारीख 21 जून, 1988 के उक्त अधिसूचना की अनुसूची में क्रम संख्या 1 से 3 पर विनिर्दिष्ट कार्यों की बाबत राजपत्र में इस अधिसूचना के प्रकाशन की तारीख से साढ़े तीन वर्ष की अवधि के लिए इन शर्तों के अधीन रहते हुए, लागू होने से छूट देती है कि, कर्मकारों को न्यूनतम मजदूरी अधिनियम, 1948 (1948 का 11) के अधीन सरकार द्वारा विहित मजदूरों और नियमित कर्मकारों के समाने नीचे प्रवर्ग, अर्थात् राष्ट्रीय कोयला मजदूरी करार के प्रवर्ग 1 को संदेय मजदूरी के बीच मजदूरी का मुँदाय किया जाएगा जिसमें मूल वेतन और मंहगाई भत्ता तथा भविष्य निधि के फायदे और कोयला कंपनों को कोयला खान औपधालय भी सम्मिलित है।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 8th October, 2004

S.O. 1095(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 31 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 (37 of 1970), the Central Government after consultation with the Central Advisory Contract Labour Board, hereby exempts Eastern Coal Fields Limited from the applicability of the notification No. S.O. 2063 dated the 21st June, 1988 of the Government of India in the Ministry of Labour in respect of works specified in the Schedule to the notification at serial numbers 1 to 3 for a period of three and half years with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette subject to the conditions that the workers shall be paid wages in the midway between the wages prescribed by the Government under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (11 of 1948) and the wages payable to the lowest category of regular workers that is Category 1 of National Coal Wage Agreement, comprising of Basic Pay plus Dearness Allowance and benefits of Provident Fund as well as medical facilities in the Colliery Dispensaries of coal company.

NOTIFICATION


S.O. No. 2063 ..... In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 (37 of 1970) and in supersession of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Labour No.S.O.488, dated the 1st February 1975, published in the Gazette of India, Para II, Section 3, Sub-section (ii), dated the 15th February, 1975, the Central Government after consultation with the Central Board, hereby prohibits employment of contract labour in the works specified in the schedule annexed hereto in all coal mines in the country.

THE SCHEDULE

1. Raising or raising-cum-selling of coal;
2. Coal loading and unloading;
3. Over burden removal and earth cutting;
4. Soft coke manufacturing;
5. Driving of stone drifts and miscellaneous stone cutting underground;

Provided that this notification shall not apply to the following categories:-

- (a) quarries in the North-East Coal field which can only be worked for a few months every year due to heavy rainfall in the area;
- (b) quarries located by the side of the river in punch valley and similar other patch deposits which can only be worked when the level of river has gone down and during non-rainy season;
- (c) loading of coal when there is mechanical failure; failure of power or irregular supply of wagon by the railways; and
- (d) cutting of stone drifts/faults which cannot be detected in advance and are of short-duration, say upto six months.
