The main drievance of the petitioner is that a murder trial of trade Union Leader - Shankar Guha Neugi held in Camera and the Chhatisgarh Mukti Morcha and the complainants are not being allowed to assist the Court. On the other hand the witnesses are being terrorized and humiliated during their examination.

The laws is well settled that criminal trial manded take place in open Court. Heliance was placed, on a decision of the Supreme Court in case of Kehar Singh (ALR 1988 SC 1883) and a decision of Calcutta High Court in case of Numar Purnent Mith Tagore V. Kelipada Dutt and others (ALR 1985 CALCUTTA 513)
