## CHAPTER -III

## REFERENCE OF DISPUTES TO BOARD/COUNCILS

- 12. Reference of disputes to Board or councils:
- (1) Where the appropriate unit of the Board is of opinion that any dispute exists or is apprehended it may at any time, by order in writing:-
  - (a) refer the dispute to the Board for promoting a settlement thereof; or
    - (b) refer any matter appearing to be connected with or relevant to the dispute to a Council for inquiry; or for resolution of the dispute as provided in the scheme.
- (2) No proceedings pending before a Dispute resolution

  Council or the appellate authority in relation to an industrial dispute shall lapse merely by reason of the death of any of the parties to the dispute being a workman, and such council or appellate authority shall complete such proceedings and submits it award to the appropriate unit of the Board.
