

RESOLUTION PASSED AT THE MEETING OF THE CENTRAL EXECUTIVE
COMMITTEE OF THE DAKSHIN RAILWAY EMPLOYEES UNION HELD AT
GOLDEN ROCK ON 6-1-1974.

In the resolution of the Working Committee in its meeting of 27-9-73, for taking all steps for a united action against the betrayal of the JCM negotiators at Delhi scuttling the Need Based Minimum wage, full neutralisation and bonus and other basic demands of the Central Govt. employees, the DREU had warned the employees and other sister trade unions sufficiently earlier. Then came the actual betrayal by a section of the JCM in arriving at an agreement with the Government accepting Rs. 196/- as the minimum wage for class IV staff with other paltry concessions while the minimum in several public sector undertaking has gone up above Rs.300/- for unskilled labour.

This meeting of the CEC totally rejects the above agreement and the Government announcement and reiterate its earlier demand of a minimum wage of Rs. 314/-, full neutralisation, Service weightage and Bonus to all as the minimum if a nation wide strike is to be averted.

It therefore calls upon the entire Railwaymen and other employees of the Central Government to forge a united Action Council at the All India level and below at all levels and to fix a suitable agreed date for nation-wide strike.

This meeting further requests the president of the AIRF to take the initiative to call an early convention of the representatives of all Railway Trade Unions and all Central Govt. employees Unions and to form a joint United Council of Action for this purpose so that the respective Unions at their levels will follow suit and make immediate preparation for a general strike., the date of which to be announced in the National Convention to be called.

ऑल इण्डिया रेल्वे मैन्स फेडरेशन के अध्यक्ष श्री जार्ज फरनाडिस की सरकार को चेतावनी—

रेल कर्मचारी किसी भी समय आम हड़ताल के लिए तैयार रहें—

साथियों,

लोको रनिंग स्टाफ की हड़ताल से उत्पन्न हुई स्थिति पर विचार करते हुए फेडरेशन के अध्यक्ष श्री जार्ज फरनाडिस ने कल सरकार को चेतावनी दी है कि ऑल इण्डिया रेल्वे मैन्स फेडरेशन-लोको रनिंग कर्मचारियों की ८ घंटे की ड्यूटी, समान कार्य के लिए समान वेतन, डॉक्टरों में फेल होने वाले कर्मचारियों के वेतन की पूर्ण सुरक्षा इत्यादि मांगों का पूर्ण रूप से समर्थन करता है। उन्होंने यह भी कहा है कि मौजूदा हड़ताल की उत्पन्न स्थिति के लिए सरकार ही पूर्ण रूप से जिम्मेदार है। जार्ज फरनाडिस ने सरकार को आगाह किया कि फेडरेशन (A.I.R.F.) न केवल लोको रनिंग स्टाफ की उपरोक्त मांगों के लिए ही बल्कि उन तमाम मांगों को, जैसे कि पे कमीशन की रिपोर्ट १ जनवरी सन् १९७० से लागू करना, न्यूनतम वेतन, बोनस, सस्ते अनाज की दुकान व बढ़ते हुए भावों के साथ महंगाई पूर्ण निष्कृत्यकरण, जिम्मेदारी के मुताबिक वेतन तथा कर्मचारियों का वर्गीकरण—मनवाने के लिए किसी भी समय अनिश्चित काल के लिए आम हड़ताल का आह्वान कर सकता है जिसके लिए पूर्ण जिम्मेदारी सरकार की होगी।

अतः सभी साथियों से प्रार्थना है कि यूनियन के अल्प काल के नोटिस पर अनिश्चित काल की आम हड़ताल के लिए तैयार हो जायें।

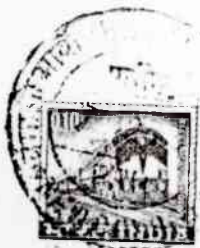
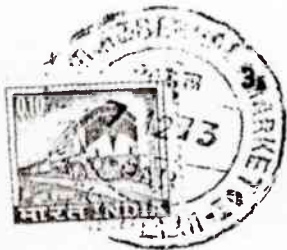

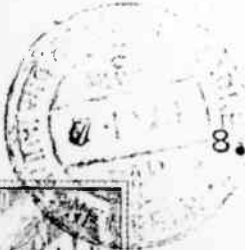
