ON THE NUCLEAR DEAL – A Note

Dear Satya Pal Bhai,

I got your post card of the 26 Nov. on the evening of 28 Nov. During the last few days I have been trying to write something, but without much success. As you say, this question is highly controversial. It has become more so because of the present political situation, including the line up during the Gujarat elections and the expectation that general elections could be held earlier than scheduled. As I try to write now, the Parliament has just finished the debate on the question, raising much heat and dust and marked by many walkouts. I have also watched some of the television discussions and read quite a few articles in the press. The Parliament debate concluded with the long and forceful speech and appeal of Foreign Minister Pranab Mukherjee to the Left and Right both to support the government which agrees with what was committed earlier but is not obliged to agree to every condition now being proposed by the American Congress.

Apart from the debate in the Parliament, the general discussion in the media shows clearly that experts who understand the technicalities are also not of one opinion. As for the political parties, including the Congress, many within them hold different opinions though they may not express them at present due to 'party discipline'. The factual position is that *the deal is not likely to be made operational by the Indian government within the time stipulated* and the Americans now understand this. A report from Washington in The Hindu of Dec. 7 quotes the US State Department deputy spokesman Tom Casey as saying: "In terms of the decisions within the Indian political system we (the US) respect the needs and the rights of their political leaders to work this through themselves. But we are ready and able to move forward *whenever they (India) would like us to.*" He, however, said that regardless of the outcome or the timing of the agreement, Washington would continue to expand its relations with New Delhi, which was "an increasingly important player on the world stage." Those in the media and others who have been trying to assert that the Prime Minister should resign if his position and his appeals to the majority of the Parliament are not accepted, have been effectively answered by chief Congress spokesman Abhishek Singhvi himself that if the PM resigns on this issue as a matter of prestige, it will lead to the collapse of the UPA government and the deal will still not be signed.

The fact is that Bush has fast been losing his popularity in America itself and his party is most unlikely to win the next elections because of his unpopular Iraq and Afghanistan policy. After his failure in these two countries, Americans do not want to risk the lives of their soldiers and citizens to attack one more foreign country – Iran.

My feeling is that India should stop its drift into the American camp and return to non-alignment. In this it will have the support of Russia and China. Post-Yeltsin Russia has realised its mistake of trusting the Americans too much. Putin is not a supporter of the Soviet system, but he has rebuilt Russian economy and regained Russia its place as a world power, and the results of the recent Russian parliamentary elections have proved this. (Incidentally, the Russian parliamentary elections are far more democratic

than ours and are based on proportional representation to political parties rather than 'first past the post' principle in which a candidate securing even a small percentage of votes can win, if he polls more votes than a dozen other candidates.)

Globalisation cannot now be reversed, but it can be replaced by genuine internationalism. No so-called socialist country is building socialism. A A

A The recent Party Congress in China has recognised the role of private enterprise and given its representatives the right to join the Party. In its foreign policy China has been a 'strategic partner' of Pakistani dictatorships so far rather than Indian democracy. India should try to occupy its place in international politics as a natural leader of South Asian countries and stop dreaming of becoming a 'great world power'. It can also play a useful role in the Commonwealth and contribute to reform the antiquated UN Constitution.

✓ It should work for total nuclear disarmament and for the use of nuclear energy only for peaceful purposes, which was the basis of Nehru's foreign policy. In the economic sphere, it should give priority to infra-structural sectors like education, health, housing, roads, public transport, and safety of environment, rather than producing more cars and motor-cycles. We have a vast internal market and should attract foreign assistance to develop and satisfy its requirements.

7 As for our political parties, especially of the Left, they should democratise their structure and work in common mass organisations, as in pre-independence days. Party fractions cannot and should not replace the democratically-elected committees of mass organisations. Recent events in West Bengal and Kerala have shown the danger of one-party hegemonism, which inevitably leads to the destruction of inner-party democracy and ultimately to the rise of a single supreme leader (like Stalin and Mao). A clear distinction should be made between the role of the state and the party and the party should never usurp the role and functions of the state. Every political party should work strictly within the country's constitution.

✓ Legislative organs should be allowed to function and members of Parliament and state legislative assemblies should have no special privileges.

✓ What I have written above is much more than on the question of the nuclear deal. But the question of the nuclear deal is closely connected with the healthy functioning of our political party system. At present we do not discuss any important question in a democratic manner but try to win our argument by staging walkouts and dharnas inside our parliament and legislative assemblies. We are certainly not a real democracy and our parliament and assemblies and even panchayats are becoming more and more corrupt. Winning elections by hook or by crook is no indicator of a true democracy. The power of money should have no role in our electoral system. A A A We have created a narrow trade union bureaucracy which fights for the most privileged section of the organised workers and not the vast mass of the working people. We have also created an internal colonial system in which the people of impoverished states go to work as cheap labour to more prosperous states. 
We are in fact adding more prestige to our prestigious Dr Adhikari award by conferring it upon you.
