This year publication of the magazine "Teachers of the World" which appears in English, French, German and Spanish will recommence on a regular bases. The principal tasks of the magazine are to contribute to the development of democratic education in all countries, to defend the rights and interests, both economic and social, of teachers and their organisations, to assist in the establishment and development of unity among teachers and their union with the working class and with all workers, to promote mutual understanding, peaceful coexistence and peace and friendship among peoples. In addition, the publication will offer the possibility to teachers of different countries to exchange their opinions and experiences concerning pedagogical problems, methods of teaching and education, and other questions which concern them.

- 4.- The participation of teachers in peoples' movements for disarmament and the prohibition of atomic and hydrogen weapons, and for peaceful coexistence and peace and friendship among peoples.
- 5.- Problems of unity among teachers and their union with the working class and with all working people.
- 6.- Activities of teachers' organisations.
- 7.- Problems in contemporary pedagogy.
- 8.- Problems in child psychology.
- 9.- Teaching methods for various subjects.
- 10.- Developments in science and technology.
- 11.- Critiques and bibliographies of works on problems in education.
- 12.- Other questions.
