

You are undoubtedly aware that the 35th session of AIPUC is being held in Patna, Bihar from 11th - 15th March, 1994.



Dear comrade,

We are extremely thankful to you for having agreed to host the AITUC Conference at Patna from 11th March to 15th March 1994. The Secretariat discussed the same and has approved of the dates. Now it is for you to move further and make all the organisational arrangements.

We know you are all experienced enough in conducting such all India Conferences. However, we think you may consider the following suggestions being given on the basis of past experiences.

1. Formation of Reception Committee. To make it as broad-based as possible so that friendly sections of the society could be involved in the campaign to make the Conference a success.
2. Food - arrangements left to you. Meals including breakfast will have to be served for about 2000 delegates.
3. Accommodation:
 - i) For foreign delegates;
 - ii) For office bearers and important leaders of AITUC including some comrades from AITUC office staff.
 - iii) For delegates in Community Halls etc as may be convenient for you.
 - please take care to provide cots, beds blankets and Mosquito nets (if necessary) as it will be cold in Patna. Hot water facilities if possible. Enough toilets and bath rooms.
4. Medical facilities to be provided during the Conference.

5. Arrangement for the press (Journalists): Telephones, Fax etc. and separate place for them.

6. AITUC office functioning during Conference; Seperate place in the Conference Hall with at least 3 typewriters and a duplicator along with Typists (English and Hindi knowing) and duplicator operators.

7. Railway Booking counter - for delegates etc. and arrangements made with the Railways.

8. Printing AITUC Report: Draft will be sent as soon as it is ready. To get the same translated into Hindi. To be printed in English and Hindi (About 1500 copies in English and 1000 in Hindi).

9. Mike equipment, decoration of the hall etc. to be done

10. Arrangements for mass rally, propogainda and suitable publicity.

11. Volunteers (a) to receive comrades at Railway Station bus terminal and Airport and (b) for the Conference hall (c) mass rally.

12. Organising an Exhibition of Public Sector and other industries. Also on History of Trade Union movement (AITUC in Bihar to be thought of.

13. Bringing out a souvernair on the occasion.

14. Cultural programme, singing squads during Conference.

15. Transport arrangements for foreign delegates to receive them at Station/Airport, bringing them to Conferer Hall and taking them back.

- Also transport of delegates to Conference Hall and back if it is felt necessary.



17. You have to collect Rs.125/- ^{from each} ~~per~~ delegate for providing two meals, tea, breakfast, etc. out of which Rs.25/- to be given to AITUC towards expenses.
