

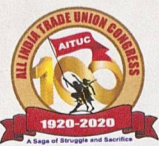

We have received the copies of your telegram and othe representations with regard to the retrenchment in the PWD. Immediately on receipt of the news, we took up the matter with the Union Labour Minister. We have however had no response as yet from the Labour Minister. The question will however be put before the Parliament and our MPs will take it up when the next session starts from the 7th Sept.

We fully realise that in a place like Andamans where job opportunities are limited, the retrenchment has caused grave distress. The AITUC condemns this action by the authorities and assures solidarity with the PWD workers.
