

We are very glad to receive your letter No.AIRF/160-B(VIII) dated 18-2-74 inviting us to attend the convention of all Government employees' organisation to be held in New-Delhi on 15th March, 1974. We have already communicated about your invitation to all of 'w affiliated Associations all over Arunachal Pradesh.

It would indeed be of much use for us to participate in the proposed Convention at New Telhi but it is regretted that we are much too occupied with our local problems including finalisation of pay-structure and as such it would not be possible on our part to send any delegate to the Convention presently. We do hope that some useful and purposeful decisions will be arrived at, and the Convention will chalk-out concrete measures to guide the future course of action of the employees and the workers in the country at large.

It would be pertinent to mention here that the Third Pay Commission had left the important issue of revision of pay-scales for Arunachal Pradesh employees in a state of flux, and consequently we have been put in a rather awkward situation. We are trying for reasons to prevail with the Govt. but, as you know better, the Govt. is not prepared to settle the issue with an open mind. We, the employees of Arunachal Pradesh have conveyed our clear-cut preference for adoption of Central pattern of pay-scales as opposed to the present linkage with Assam Govt. pay-structure. Inspite of this option exercised by us, the Govt., as usual, is trying to confuse matters and impose arbitrary sets of things on us. We are, therefore, looking forward to emergence of fruitful decisions and guidemines at the New-Delhi Convertion in concerted struggle by the employees and workers throughout the country. The employees of Arunachal Pradesh will be always in readiness to extend all moral and material support to the cause as may be defined by the Convention.

We are employees of Geological Survey of India which is the prime agency in exploring the Mineral Wealth in our country. The employees of the G.S.I. are required to move into the jungles, remote and virgin areas where human life and inhabitance is normally not accessable, and remain there for years together in quest of minorals away from family life and without any proper compensation. Apart from the hazardous and miserable life, the Department of CSI has made our lives further miserable by keeping pending our demands, concerning service conditions, for years togother non-finalised. Though our problems/demands were discussed with the Departmental authorities on many occassions also under the various tiers of J.C.M., nothing fruitful is forthcoming. The various tiers of J.C.M. seem to go to the advantage of the authorities to adopt delatory tactics to side tract the issued thus defeating the purpose of J.C.M. This sometime leads to infer that the various tiers under J.C.H. were created to help the sutherities in keeping the legitimate demans of the employees permanently pending. But this may not nor is desirable to continue indefinitely. If the employees are not kept satisfied, jeopanue indefinitely. rdising the work of public interest, the fate of exploration of mineral wealth in the country could well be imagined. But the innocent employees are on with the job, postponing the agitational programmes for achieving demands, on the assurance given by the Department from the time to time spreading over a period of a decade. The height of patience has been enhausted by the employees. The delatory tactics adopted by the Department has compelled the employees to infer that nothing could be achieve without agitation. It has therefore, been resolved to start the already many times postponed agitational programmes with effect from 19.3.76 and intensify the same in the subsequent days followed by indefinite hunger strike till the decands are finalised.

We are attaching hereto a copy of our charter of demands with carnest hope that you will very kindly raise the same in the parliament or any other quarter which you does proper so that our long-outeranding demands are amicably settled before the nituation takes any unhappy turn.

We are in receipt of your communication with reference to AIRF/160-B(viii) dated 18th Feb.1974, and thank you for the same. This association appreciate your organisation for having the opportunity to convene the golden convention of State & Central Govt. Employees in Delhi. Surely our representative namely the undersigned and Vice President Mr. Thakur Singh will be attending the convention.

The following is the text of Resolution passed in the Executive Committee Meeting of this Association held on the 22nd day of Feb. 1974, on National Wage Policy for your consideration and submission to the convention of Central and State Govt. Employees to be held in Delhi on 15th & 16th March 1974.

In the present inflationary climate, the wage earners, Doctors, Engineers, Nurses, Teachers, Technicians and other class of professional earners have demanded wage increase. The Govt. is reluctant to give any rise in salary. It is true that Govt. has agreed to give considerable relief to the professionals in some public enterprises. A Major section of mass have been deprived of any increase in the income. This has resulted in discontent. The signs of this growing discontent are in evidence everywhere. The revolt in U.P., the strike of Power Engineers, the strike in Railways in LIC and IAC etc. are the kind of chaos they they can let loose in the country.

On the other hand strike and bandh have over powered the production and distribution net work of the country. We should not allow the country to throw to the dark continent. The root cause of this seething discontent is the Governments willingness to cave in to the slightest pressure for the rise in wages from organised groups. Over the years this has resulted in the steady impoverishment of the hither to unorganised professional cadres in the Central and State Services, in both relative and absolute terms. Not only have their salaries begun to lag behind those of the organised groups, but even what they earn has bought less and less because of the high rise in prices triggered by the massive wage and salary increases granted to others. The

cumulative effect of the Govt.'s policies have been to turn the entire income structure in the country upside down. The average

(54)

worker in a public sector undertaking earns Rs. 820/- or more per month, even without taking into calculation the subsidised housing and education for their children, and free medical facilities. A peon in LIC is being offered a salary which is quite equivalent to a class II gazetted officer in Central Service, with no fringe benefits. Then let us observe what is being offered to a class IV Central Staff ie. merely Rs. 196/- at index No. 200 (1960=100). Similarly a foreman at the Bhilai Steel Plant earns over Rs. 2000/- per month according one statistic, which is more than all except Two to Three doz of its top managers receive.

All these factors have emerged a black market tendency in the community thereby enforcing an artificial scarcity over all essential commodities things are short supply or hoarded. The Govt. machinery also becoming corrupt to the practice. In these circumstances a Co-ordinated incomes and price policy is long overdue. If the Govt.cannot being order into the present chaos by standing firm against the demands of the organised working class, it will have no option but to alleviate the growing distress of the professional cadres.

The wage should be linked up to the price and also to the strain on work involved but not to the paying capacity of the employer. It is high time that the Govt. Should announce a National Wage and income policy that should regulate salaries for all known categories of employees all over India and in all firms or concerns whether Private or Public. The grades for any category at any cost should be similar in all sectors.

The terms of National Wage Commission shall be the accepted recommendation of 15th Indian Labour Conference Norms. The common guide lines may be provided to them by the Commission itself and in such an elaborate evaluation, the following principle shall be taken into account.

- 1. Educational Qualifications.
- 2. Experience involved.
- Training required.
- 4. Degree of skill.
  - 5. Strain on work.
  - 6. Monetary and other responsibilities.
  - 7. Physical and Mental alertness.
  - 8. Strains of outdoor duties.
  - 9. Strain on split duty.
- 10. Dealing with public and tackling of situations in relation to them.
