The Bombay Vegetable Markets Unprotected Workers (Regulation of Employment and Welfare) Scheme into force in 22-1-1985 and the Clause 11(ii) & 14 of the scheme dealing with registration of the Workers and employers came into force from Feb. 1986.

These workers who were employed in Vegetable Markets and Other Establishment in the Trade in ~~the~~ connection with loading, unloading, stacking, carrying, weighing, measuring or such other work including work preparatory or incidental to such operations. Those employer including a Mukadam, commission agent, clearing agent, purchaser, importer, exporter engaged in selling, purchasing or trading or acting as agent in vegetable market and other establishments in the Greater Bombay dealing with registration under clause 14 of the ~~Scheme~~ scheme.

Questionnaire 2:
