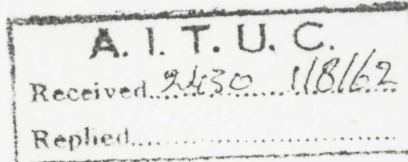

**Sub :- Fourth Meeting of State
Implementation & Evaluation
Committee.**

The fourth meeting of State Implementation & Evaluation Committee was held on 25th inst.

Since our Representative on the Committee Shri B. S. Dhume has been out of Country some time past, we had nominated Shri G. Sundaram, a member of our Executive, to represent us at the meeting.

On the day previous to the meeting Shri Durve, Secy., State I. & E. Committee, informed our Office that our Shri G. Sundaram, would not be allowed to substitute for Shri Dhume.

We asked for a written reply to our letter nominating Shri Sundaram, but that was never done.

The matter was raised with you. It was pointed out to you that it had been the practice of the Committee to allow substitutes. We pointed out that in the very first meeting of the Committee Shri Prabhu Mehta, a representative of the All India Machinery Manufacturers' Organisation on the Committee who could not attend, was allowed to be substituted by one Shri K. Naoroji.

In spite of this, however, Shri Sunderam was not allowed to attend the meeting.

This approach adopted by you towards our Organisation is therefore, we must say, discriminatory. We record our protest against this discrimination.-

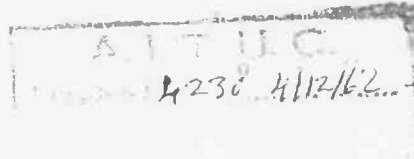

Dear Comrade,

An urgent meeting of the Executive of the MRTUC was held yesterday to consider the implementation of the resolution of the General Council of the AITUC in the State, and the situation arising out of indiscriminate arrests of trade union leaders and functionaries in the State.

A copy of the decisions of the Executive is being sent to you separately.

Out of the 39 members on the Executive, 15 have been arrested so far under the P.D.Act.

Of these several are AITUC's and MRTUC's nominees on different Tripartite Bodies. The Executive considered this situation and decided to substitute its nominees on two of the State Bodies. The new nominees are Coms. G. Sunderam on the State Labour Advisory Board and Com. S.G. Patkar on the State Evaluation and Implementation Committee.

As regards the AITUC nominees, the Executive has decided to bring it to the notice of the AITUC. These are as follows:

- 1) Com. Vithal Chaudhary .. Central Committee of the Workers' Education Board.
- 2) Com. A.B. Bardhan - Central Committee for P.F.
- 3) Com. Krishna Whopkar .. Central Development Council for Woolen Industry.

The Executive further decided that should the AITUC decide to change it's nominee on the Central P.F. Committee, it should be requested to consider Com. K.W. Joglekar's name for nomination on it.



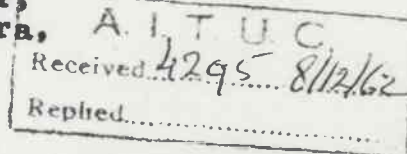

We presume that the Commission would want to hear us only as regards conditions in Bombay and Maharashtra, and that it is not one of the general sittings where the AITUC would be heard on the basis of its Replies.

With this assumption we suggest that the following five should be included in the delegation from Bombay.

- 1) Com. Sunderam,
- 2) Com. S.G. Patkar,
- 3) Com. K.T. Sule,
- 4) Com. D.S. Nargolkar
- 5) Com. G.V. Chitnis.

In addition we would like somebody from the AITUC Centre who has been handling this matter and is in touch with the work of the Commission so far, to join the delegation.

This is necessary to achieve co-ordination in our approach to the Commission, and the evidence that we would be tendering in different centres.

We would therefore request you to depute somebody for this.

३ We are calling a meeting of the above five on 31st inst. at 10 A.M. in order to have consultations and exchange of views as regards our positions to be put up before the Commission.

It would be better if your representative as well could attend this meeting.


3 Also we are organising a meeting of TU activists on 2nd proximo at 6 P.M. to explain our positions before the Bonus Commission, and its proceedings on that day.
